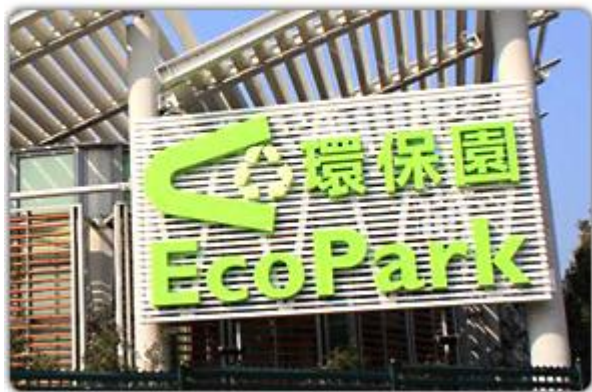

EcoPark is an environmental infrastructure project located in Tsun Mun, Hong Kong. It is a government initiative aimed at promoting sustainability and environmental awareness. The park covers 20-hectare that houses various facilities related to waste management, recycling, and environmental education. Some of the key facilities include a recycling centre, a waste electrical and electronic equipment treatment and recycling facility, a food waste treatment facility, a reuse shop, and an environmental education center.

EcoPark also features an environmental education centre that offers educational programs, workshops, and guided tours to raise awareness about environmental issues and promote sustainable practices. Visitors can explore EcoPark and learn more about waste management, recycling, and environmental conservation. It serves as a platform for promoting a green and sustainable lifestyle in Hong Kong.
